## MESA Program celebrates Graduates, Scholarship Awardees, and Industry of the Year!

Students of the San Diego State University Mathematics Engineering Science Achievement (MESA) program were recognized at the 35th Annual SDSU MESA Graduation & Scholarship Reception held at the Parma Payne Goodall Alumni Center on April 26, 2019.

12 Scholarships were awarded thanks to supporters Northrop Grumman, Rick Engineering Company, Solar Turbines, and the MESA Alumni Fund. Additional sponsorships were made by SDG&E and high achieving students with SDSU GPA of 3.5 and higher were presented with a medal.
